When Officer Izzo is not protecting and serving, you can find him watching his beloved Chicago White Sox.







Business Tip:

ERTC - (If you have a company with a payroll) Before you submit your tax return, be sure to check if you are eligible for ERTC. (Employee Retention Tax Credits) If your business was forced to shut down <u>fully or partially</u> during the pandemic or if you have a drop in revenue of 20% in any quarter compared to 2019's income, you may be eligible for up to **\$7,000** *per person* per quarter for 2021. Be sure to check with your tax advisor on this **BEFORE** filing your 2021 business tax return.

Sick and Family Leave Credits - You may be entitled to a tax credit if you're self-employed and were <u>unable</u> to work between January 1 and September 30, 2021, for one or more of the following reasons:

Sole Proprietors and Single-Member LLCs also qualify

- You or someone you were caring for was subject to a federal, state, or local quarantine or isolation order related to COVID-19.
- You or someone you were caring for was advised by a health care provider to self-quarantine due to concerns related to COVID-19.
- You were experiencing symptoms of COVID-19 and seeking a medical diagnosis.
- You were exposed to COVID-19 or were waiting for results of a test or diagnosis.
- You were getting a COVID-19 vaccination or taking someone else to get one.
- You or someone you were caring for was recovering from an injury, disability, illness, or condition related to the vaccination; or
- You provided certain coronavirus-related care to a son or daughter whose school or place of care was closed or whose childcare provider was unavailable for reasons related to COVID-19.

If you were affected, it is up to <u>\$5,110</u> tax credits
If you had to care for someone it could be up to an <u>additional \$10,000</u> in tax credits


