Street Scaping Coming to Archer Ave

The Chamber has been working with Alderman Tabares. She has allocated \$250,000.00 to spruce up our neighborhood. These funds will be used to replace existing light poles, garbage cans and benches on Archer Avenue, from Harlem Avenue west through Narragansett.

The updates will break ground in the upcoming weeks. They will add a patriotic flare to one of our main thoroughfares and bring branding and marketing opportunities for Garfield Ridge. Keep an eye out for these new additions that will surely brighten our streets.

Strengthening Businesses & Communities

Veterans Triangle

Archer Avenue intersects Narragansett Avenue and 55th Street. The result is a triangular piece of land that has been used for a variety of purposes over the years and known by many as simply "the Triangle." If you go back far enough this piece of land was known as the "Turn O' The Road," because at this point Archer ceases to run diagonally as it merges with 55th to run due west. When the Sanitary and Ship Canal was being built in the 1890s, it was said that workers often gathered at this spot and held Sulky Races, horse races with a cart and person in the back.

Later, part of the land was dedicated to Lech Walesa, the Polish labor leader, and dubbed the "Lech Walesa Triangle." More recently, part of the land has been dedicated to veterans and has taken on the moniker Veterans Park. Several historic cement posts that used to adorn Archer Avenue from 1910-1990s have been reused as bases for statues honoring our fallen heroes, a fitting and timely tribute. The Garfield Ridge Chamber of Commerce (GRCC), with the help of its members, have taken on the task of decorating the Veteran's triangle for the past couple of years. Thanks to Torrey Lewis, Al Cacciottolo, Ramona Piencak, Matt Tribuzio, Tom Fitzgerald and Joe Dunk under the direction of Dr. John Baietti, for helping with seasonal displays at Lech Walesea Memorial. There is a small landing area in the middle of the triangle to access the bus stop. The updates keep improving this focal point, year after year. You may also have noticed that Dr. Baietti & his team festively decorate this area every year for Independence Day, Halloween & Christmas. This spring & summer you will also see many beautiful flowers blooming here. This team was honored last year by the Neighborhood Watch as the best decorated light display.

The Chamber held a vote last year to move forward annually with the additions of bricks. Many of these bricks are donated by families to honor both past & present Veterans of our country. You can honor your Veteran by ordering bricks here: https://www.bricksrus.com/donorsite/grcc.

The Farmers Market will be hosting a brand new event this year! **PIZZA WARS!**



Business Tip:

Cash flow, not profits, is the lifeline of your business.

When applying for loans and lines of credit, cash flow is the important part of the equation. Example....

Company XYZ has a total profit of \$48,000 for the year and a monthly mortgage/loan payment of \$36,000. The bank will take the total profit and loan payments and come up with a monthly average. In this example... \$48,000 / 12 months = \$4,000 in income & \$36,000 / 12 months = \$3,000 in debt service. The total cash flow per month would be \$4,000 minus \$3,000 leaving you with \$1,000 per month for any future debt servicing. If you were buying a piece of equipment that cost \$500 per month you would have the cash flow to cover the debt, however, if you were looking to purchase a building with a mortgage of \$2,000 you would not have enough cash flow to cover the debt. Understanding cash flow and how banks calculate is important for any expansion/growth of a business.

With the federal reserve increasing interest rates do not be surprised if banks start to squeeze a bit tighter on lending money. If you are considering expansion, buying equipment, or buying real estate I would talk to a banker sooner than later as there are amazing SBA products available due to the pandemic. SBA 7a & 504 loans are products that allow 10% down deposits with interest rates under 5%. There also are great traditional/conventional loan products available as well.

Do not forget

- PPP Forgiveness application must be submitted and approved by SBA to avoid paying them back.
- SBA EIDL can STILL be requested for reconsideration or increase in the loan if you had applied once before 12/31/2021. Most people can log into the SBA portal and click the button "REQUEST INCREASE" or send an email to pdc.reconsideration@sba.gov requesting a reconsideration of the declined loan.

everything he has done for area!








Around Town:


