Archer Avenue

Archer Avenue runs 33.6 Miles from China Town to Lockport, it follows the original trail crossing the Chicago Portage between the Chicago River & Des Plaines River. It even has sections that align with the infamous Route 66. Following the path of the local rivers, Archer Avenue turned into the highway leading from Lake Michigan's shore through to St. Louis. In 1834, Archer Ave became the trail for the stage coaches to travel along those rivers. The first rail road was also set up along Archer's path. Named after the first commissioner of the I & M Canal, William Beatty Archer, this thoroughfare was first paved in 1910. The residents watched as horses & businessmen alike ran between the rival cities. The streets were originally lined with streets cars, fruit vendor trucks & a few gated communities.

Now lined with many supermarkets, banks, doctors, salons, bars & pizzerias, Archer Avenue is a high density, booming business community. You can stop by Archer & Nordica and Archer & Melvina to see the gate posts that guarded the original gated communities established here in 1910. Also be sure to stop into one of Archer's longest standing business: Soukal Florist! Soukal's was first established in 1916 & has served our community over 106 years ago!

Although the gravel roads and baron sides have been built up and changed many times over since it's inception, Archer Avenue holds many memories for so many people in our neighborhood.

One Native to the area was quoted saying, "I love that crooked street, it gave me the best education." He is the second of 4 generations, dating back to 1916, that were born and raised just a half block off of Archer Avenue. There are still many families that grew up here and meet at the neighborhood ball fields to watch their grandchildren play.




On July 20th, the farmers market invites everyone to join us and get a taste of some of the best slices in the world!

Business Tip:

If you FAIL to PLAN, then you better PLAN to FAIL

- PPP loans are starting to come due for anyone who was unable to have them forgiven. This means that banks will have to carry this debt on their books until the loans are paid off. The terms are for 5 years at 1%... which means banks will have to carry these loans on their balance sheets and collect only 1% on the borrowed money. While this might not seem like a big deal, it will start to reduce a bank's lending capacity. For example, let's say Bank ABC can loan 100 million dollars but has unforgiven PPP loans outstanding of nearly 40 million dollars... this would mean that the bank only has the capacity to lend 60 million. With increased costs, interest rates increased, inflation swirling around, and the likelihood that banks will start to become very tight and conservative, everyone should be planning for their cash flow. Do not be surprised if banks start to decline more loans, reduce lines of credit, and have higher interest rates to make up for their reduced capacity. This will not just affect your business but also your vendors and your customers so proper planning is critical. i.e., What if your customers must push your payment out a few extra weeks? What if your vendors must increase prices because they can't buy as much in bulk? Hopefully, you will not be caught with the hot potato.
- To properly plan for cash flow and what-if scenarios, you will need to make sure you have your books in order and can start to analyze month-over-month activity. While you are doing this, it would be a great time to talk with your tax professional and start discussing tax planning strategies. If you need a new car, should you buy an electric vehicle with tax credits of \$7,500? Should you start a retirement account to defer income tax? Or will you be able to purchase the equipment at the end of the year and qualify for bonus/section 179 depreciation?
- While there is no such thing as a crystal ball to see into the future, there are plenty of proactive approaches you can take to mitigate any risk.
- Albert Einstein said, "in the midst of every crisis, lies great opportunity." While I would never want to see any business falter, it is the normal course of life, and if you have your ducks in a row you may be able to find some opportunities if you are proactive and plan accordingly.


See Something-Say Something!


